#### Accessibility by car


The city can be reached from Budapest via the M3 and M25 motorways. Transfer time by car: 1.5h.

Trains to Eger depart from Budapest Keleti railway station, where most of the international connections arrive. Transfer time: 1h 45 min (without transfer)







#### Ceremonial Hall, Theatre Hall and Auditorium of Eszterházy Károly Catholic University

Located in the historic centre of Eger, the listed building provides an elegant environment for conferences, business events and ceremonies. Decorated with a fresco, the imposing ceremonial hall of more than 220 sqm can accommodate up to 200 people in a theatre style layout. Similar to the size of the ceremonial hall, the theatre hall, with a capacity of 120 seats, is also ideal for film viewings or meetings. In addition to halls and library rooms of various sizes, Lyceum also has a number of technical tools and equipment available for making the given event successful. The accessible building is located in a historic and inspiring area.





### ESZTERHÁZY KÁROLY CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY – AGRIA TISZK

Located in the centre of Eger, the modern, 900 sqm complex can accommodate 550 people (280 people in the form of a classroom layout, 550 people in the form of a theatre style). The event hall can be divided into 6 sections of 80 sqm each, separated by soundproof walls. The blocks can be opened or closed according to the needs of the event. Projection, active boards, LCD TVs and sound system are available in 5 different rooms simultaneously. The appropriate temperature is provided by a ceiling cooling and heating system. The building is an ideal venue for conferences, corporate and private events, meetings, wedding receptions, performances and balls. Agria TISZK meets all requirements of accessibility and visitors can easily find a parking space in front of the building in Bartók Béla Square and in the surrounding streets.






